Gamblers Help Northern Services

Intake Service/Service Coordination

A central intake service operates from 9.00 to 5.00 on **1300 133 445**. Emergency crisis calls are directed to the 24 hour Gamblers Help line on 1800 156 789

Problem gambling counselling

Problem gambling counselling is available for either a one-off session or to gain ongoing support to help deal with a gambling problem.

Financial counselling

Financial counsellors offer information, advice and counselling for financial problems caused by problem gambling. Financial counsellors can refer problem gamblers, their families and friends to specialist services for specific issues. Material aid is also available in the context of the Recovery Assistance Program guidelines.

Support Groups/Group Counselling

Getting Even Group is a support group to help people stop or control their gambling. Other group sessions are also conducted for specific groups.

Peer Connections Program

A confidential telephone support program, staffed by trained telephone volunteer support workers who have had the experience of dealing successfully with a gambling problem and by those who have survived and worked through the impact of someone else's gambling problem.
